Resolution No. 13.

A Resolution providing for a water supply system and doing all other work necessary to make a complete improvement in connection therewith within the boundaries more fully described in the body of this Resolution; creating an assessment district; creating a Local Improvement District Fund therefor; providing that payment for said improvement be made by special assessments on the property in said District under the mode of "Payment by Bonds".

WHEREAS, a majority petition of the property owners petitioning for said improvement has heretofore been filed with the Commissioners of Silver Lake Water District petitioning that a water supply system be constructed and that all necessary work in connection therewith be done necessary to conduct water from the Everett Municipal Water Supply System to the property within the boundaries herein described all in accordance with plans and specifications submitted by the Engineer employed by the Board of Water District Commissioners, and,

WHEREAS, after due hearing on said petition as provided by law it appears to the Commissioners of said Silver Lake Water District that public convenience and necessity require that the above mentioned improvement be made, now therefore,

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS OF SILVER LAKE WATER DISTRICT, SNOHOMISH COUNTY, WASHINGTON:

Section 1: That all of the territory within the boundaries described in Section 3 of this Resolution be improved by the construction and installation of a water supply system and that all necessary work in connection therewith be done necessary to conduct water from the Everett Municipal Water System to all of the property described in Section 3 of this Resolution and that said water distribution system be constructed according to plans and specifications

prepared under the direction of the Engineer employed by said Water District Commissioners for such purpose, which plans and specifications are hereby approved and adopted.

Section 2: That all of the costs and expenses of such improvement except such part as shall be borne by the general water district and/or government aid or funds from other sources shall be borne by and assessed against the property included in the assessment district herein created.

Section 3: That there is hereby established a Local Improvement District to be called Local Improvement District No. 1 which shall include all the lots, tracts, parcels of land and other property within the following described boundaries, to-wit:

Beginning at the Southwest corner of Section 17, Township 28 North Range 5 East W.M.; thence North along the West line of said Section 17 for 330 ft; thence East parallel to the south line of said Sec. 17 for 1320 ft. more or less, to the north and south centerline of the southwest quarter of said Section 17; thence North along the said centerline for 330 ft; thence east parallel to south line of said Sec. 17 for 1320 ft. more or less, to the north and south centerline of said Sec. 17; thence south along the centerline of Sec. 17 and along the centerline of Sec. 20 for 1320 ft. more or less, to the southeast corner of the north one-half of the northeast quarter of the northwest quarter of Sec. 20, said Township and Range; thence west for 1320 ft. more or less to the SW corner of said North one-half of the NE $\frac{1}{4}$ of the NW $\frac{1}{4}$ of said Sec. 20; thence south along the north and south centerline of the NW $\frac{1}{4}$ of said Sec. 20 for 1980 ft. more or less, to the north line of the Plat of Silver Lake in said Sec. 20; thence west along the north line of the last named plat for 990 ft. more or less, to a point north of the NW corner of Tract No. 2 of said Plat of Silver Lake; thence south along the west line of said Tract No. 2, Plat of Silver Lake to the SW corner of said Tract No. 2; thence east along the south line of Tracts Nos. 2 to 8, inclusive, of said Plat of Silver Lake to the east line of said Plat; thence south along the east line of the Plat of Silver Lake and continuing south along the east line of Campbell's Berry Tracts and continuing south along the east line of Walsh's Lakeside Tracts to the center of Sec. 29, said township and range; thence south along the north and south centerline of said Sec. 29 for 1320 ft. more or less, to the SE corner of the NE $\frac{1}{4}$ of the SW $\frac{1}{4}$ of said Sec. 29; thence west for 1320 ft. more or less to the SW corner of the NE $\frac{1}{4}$ of the SW $\frac{1}{4}$ of said Sec. 29; thence south 1320 ft. more or less, to the SE corner of the SW $\frac{1}{4}$ of the SW $\frac{1}{4}$ of said Sec. 29; thence continuing south for 660 ft. more or less, to the north line of Heatherwood Garden Tracts No. 3 in Sec. 32, said township and range; thence west along the north line of said Heatherwood Garden Tracts No. 3 and along said line produced to the west line of said Sec. 32; thence continuing west along the $\frac{1}{64}$ line, which is the east and west centerline of the NE $\frac{1}{4}$ of the NE $\frac{1}{4}$ of Sec. 31, said township and range, for 1320 ft. more or less to the west line

of said NE 1/4 of the NE 1/4 of said Sec. 31; thence north for 660 ft. more or less, to the north line of said Sec. 31; thence continuing north along the north and south centerline of the SE 1/4 of Sec. 30 of said township and range, to the NW corner of the NE 1/4 of the SE 1/4 of said Sec. 30; thence west for 1320 ft. more or less, to the center of said Sec. 30; thence north along the centerline of said Sec. 30 and continuing north along the centerline of Sec. 19, said township and range, to the center of said Sec. 19; thence east for 1320 ft. more or less, to the SW corner of the SE 1/4 of the NE 1/4 of said Sec. 19; thence north for 1320 ft. more or less, to the NW corner of said SE 1/4 of the NE 1/4 of said Sec. 19; thence east for 660 ft. more or less, to the SW corner of the east one-half of the NE 1/4 of the NE 1/4 of said Sec. 19; thence north along the north and south centerline of the NE 1/4 of the NE 1/4 of said Sec. 19 for 1320 ft. more or less, to the north line of said Sec. 19; thence east for 660 ft. more or less to the point of beginning, all in Snohomish County, Washington.

Section 4: A special fund is hereby created to be called Local Improvement District Fund No. 1 which shall consist in the aggregate of the several amounts assessed, levied and collected on the lots, tracts, parcels of land and other property in the said Local Improvement District and the proceeds of the sale of the bonds of said District for the purpose of defraying that part of the cost and expenses of such improvement to be borne by the Local Improvement District as outlined in Section 2 herein; out of said fund shall be paid the bonds, the interest thereon and that part of the cost of the improvement herein provided for.

Section 5: That the costs and expenses of such improvement except such part as shall be borne by the general water district and government aid or funds from other sources shall be defrayed by special assessments payable in ten, equal, annual installments under the mode of "Payment by Bonds" as provided by law; bonds bearing interest at the rate of Six (6%) per cent per annum payable on or before twelve years from date of issue shall be issued in payment of said costs and expenses above mentioned.
