Resolution establishing a wage scale to be used in the construction of a water supply system:

BE IT RESOLVED, by the Commissioners of the Silver Lake Water District:

Sec. 1. That the following wage scale be and the same hereby is established as the scale of wages to be paid in the construction of a water supply system in Local Improvement District No. 1, on which project the Public Works Administration of the United States has authorized a grant of 45% of the cost of the project, but not to exceed \$26,182.00.
