Resolution No. 21

A resolution approving and confirming the assessments and assessment roll for Local Improvement District No. 1 of the Silver Lake Water District, Snohomish County, Washington, for the improvement of the property described in Section 1 of this resolution by the construction and installation of a water supply system and doing all necessary work in connection therewith to conduct water from the Everett Municipal Water System to the property described in Section 1 of this resolution in accordance with Resolution No. 13 of said Water District passed on November 12, 1937, levying an assessment on account thereof against the several tracts, lots and parcels of land as shown on said roll; providing for the issuance of bonds therefor and fixing the date of the issuance thereof, now therefore,

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS OF SILVER LAKE WATER DISTRICT, SNOHOMISH COUNTY, WASHINGTON:

Section 1: That the assessments and assessment roll, as the same now stands, of Local Improvement District No. 1 for the improvement of the following described property in said water district, to-wit:

Beginning at the Southwest corner of Section 17, Township 28 North, Range 5 East W.M.; thence north along the west line of said Section 17 for 330 ft.; thence east parallel to the south line of said Sec. 17 for 1320 ft. more or less, to the north and south centerline of the southwest quarter of said Section 17; thence north along the said centerline for 330 ft.; thence east parallel to south line of said Sec. 17 for 1320 ft. more or less, to the north and south centerline of said Sec. 17; thence south along the centerline of Sec. 17 and along the centerline of Sec. 20 for 1320 ft. more or less, to the southeast corner of the North one-half of the northeast quarter of the northwest quarter of Sec. 20, said township and range; thence west for 1320 feet more or less, to the SW corner of said North one-half of the NE $\frac{1}{4}$  of the NW $\frac{1}{4}$  of said Sec. 20; thence south along the north and south centerline of the NW $\frac{1}{4}$  of said Sec. 20 for 1980 ft. more or less, to the north line of the Plat of Silver Lake in said Sec. 20; thence west along the north line of the last named plat for 990 ft. more or less, to a point north of the NW corner of Tract No. 2, Plat of Silver Lake; thence south along the west line of said Tract No. 2, Plat of Silver Lake, to the SW corner of said Tract No. 2; thence east along the south line of Tracts Nos. 2 to 8 inclusive, of said Plat of Silver Lake to the east line of said Plat; thence south along the east line of the Plat of Silver Lake and continuing south along the east line of Campbell's Berry Tracts and continuing south along the east line of Walsh's Lakeside Tracts to the center of Sec. 29, said township and range

thence south along the north and south centerline of said Sec. 29 for 1320 ft. more or less, to the SE corner of the NE $\frac{1}{4}$  of the SW $\frac{1}{4}$  of said Sec. 29; thence west for 1320 ft. more or less to the SW corner of the NE $\frac{1}{4}$  of the SW $\frac{1}{4}$  of said Sec. 29; thence south 1320 ft. more or less to the SE corner of the SW $\frac{1}{4}$  of the SW $\frac{1}{4}$  of said Sec. 29; thence continuing south for 660 ft. more or less to the north line of Heatherwood Garden Tracts No. 3 in Sec. 32, said township and range; thence west along the north line of said Heatherwood Garden Tracts No. 3 and along said line produced, to the west line of said Sec. 32; thence continuing west along the 1/64 line, which is the east and west center line of the NE $\frac{1}{4}$  of the NE $\frac{1}{4}$  of Section 31, said township and range, for 1320 ft. more or less, to the west line of said NE $\frac{1}{4}$  of the NE $\frac{1}{4}$  of said Sec. 31; thence north for 660 feet more or less to the north line of said Sec. 31; thence continuing north along the north and south centerline of the SE $\frac{1}{4}$  of Section 30 of said township and range to the NW corner of the NE $\frac{1}{4}$  of the SE $\frac{1}{4}$  of said Sec. 30; thence west for 1320 ft. more or less, to the center of said Sec. 30; thence north along the centerline of said Sec. 30 and continuing north along the centerline of Sec. 19, said township and range; to the center of said Sec. 19; thence east for 1320 ft. more or less, to the SW corner of the SE $\frac{1}{4}$  of the NE $\frac{1}{4}$  of said Sec. 19; thence north for 1320 ft. more or less, to the NW corner of said SE $\frac{1}{4}$  of the NE $\frac{1}{4}$  of said Sec. 19; thence east for 660 ft. more or less to the SW corner of the east one-half of the NE $\frac{1}{4}$  of the NE $\frac{1}{4}$  of said Sec. 19; thence north along the north and south centerline of the NE $\frac{1}{4}$  of the NE $\frac{1}{4}$  of said Sec. 19 for 1320 ft. more or less, to the north line of said Sec. 19; thence east for 660 ft. more or less, to the point of beginning, all in Snohomish County, Washington.

by the construction and installation of a water supply system and doing all necessary work in connection therewith to conduct water from the Everett Municipal Water System to the property above described in accordance with resolution No. 13, passed on November 12, 1937, be and the same hereby is in all things approved and confirmed.

Section 2: That each of the lots, tracts and parcels of land or other property shown on said roll is hereby declared to be specially benefited by said improvement in at least the amount charged against the same and that the assessment appearing against the same is in proportion to the several assessments appearing upon said roll and there is hereby levied an assessment against each lot, tract and parcel of land or other property the amount finally charged against the same.

Section 3: That the 24<sup>th</sup> day of June, 1939, is hereby fixed as the date for the issuance of the bonds

required to be issued on account of said improvement.

Section 4. The Board of Commissioners of the said Silver Lake Water District finds that on May 1, 1939, at 7:30 o'clock P.M. at the Silver Lake School Auditorium in said School District was the time and place heretofore fixed by the order of said Commissioners for the hearing upon the assessment roll of Local Improvement District No. 1 of said Water District; that said assessment roll was duly filed with the said Commission before the fixing of the time for hearing thereon; that due notice of the hearing upon the said assessment roll at said time and place has been given by publication in the Everett Daily Herald, a newspaper published in Snohomish County, Washington, and of general circulation within said district; that said notice was published in said newspaper on April 15, April 22, and April 29, 1939 and that due proof of said publication has been filed with said Commission, and that no objections or protests have been filed to the said assessment roll.
