RESOLUTION NO. 424

A RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS OF THE SILVER LAKE WATER DISTRICT SETTING AND ESTABLISHING SEWER SERVICE RATES FOR THE CUSTOMERS OF THE DISTRICT

WHEREAS, after proper notice, due hearing was held on October 24, 1991 by the Board of Commissioners of the Silver Lake Water District to consider an adjustment to the sewer rates of the District; and

WHEREAS, certain capital improvements benefiting the sewer system of the District are being constructed at this time; and

WHEREAS, the selling of revenue bonds to finance such capital improvements and to maintain and operate the District in an efficient manner is required; and

WHEREAS, after due deliberation the Board of Commissioners of the Silver Lake Water District has determined to amend the sewer rates of the District.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS OF THE SILVER LAKE WATER DISTRICT SNOHOMISH COUNTY, WASHINGTON AS FOLLOWS:

1. DEFINITIONS:

A. "Domestic user" means any and all customers of the District discharging domestic wastewater only to the District sewerage system.

B. "Domestic Wastewater" means water carrying human wastes, including kitchen, bath and laundry wastes from residences, buildings, industrial establishments or other places, together with such groundwater infiltration or surface water as may be present.

C. "Industrial user" means any and all customers of the District discharging industrial wastewater to the District sewerage system.

D. "Industrial wastewater" means the water or liquid carried waste from industrial or commercial processes, as distinct from domestic wastewater. These wastes may result from any process or activity of industry, manufacture, trade or business, from the development of any natural resource, or from animal operations such as feedlots, poultry houses or dairies. The term includes contaminated storm water and also leachate from solid waste facilities.


E. "Residential equivalent" equals the total gallons per day flow divided by 221.

2. DOMESTIC SEWER RATES: All domestic user customers of the district shall be charged a sewer rate of twenty two dollars and twenty-five cents (\$22.25) per month for each residence.

3. INDUSTRIAL USER SEWER RATES: Each industrial user customer of the District shall pay a monthly sewer rate equal to 1.07 times the domestic user sewer rate per each residential equivalent for such industrial user.

4. EFFECTIVE DATE: The rates established by this resolution shall be effective January 1, 1992 and shall remain in full force and effect until further amended or changed by the action of the Board of Commissioners.
