

RESOLUTION NO 441

A RESOLUTION OF THE SILVER LAKE WATER DISTRICT IN SUPPORT OF CERTAIN PROPERTY OWNERS TO HAVE THEIR PROPERTY INCLUDED IN THE SNOHOMISH COUNTY UGA AND REPRESENTATION THAT WATER AND SEWER FACILITIES FOR SUCH PROPERTIES COULD BE OBTAINED BY THESE PROPERTIES BY DEVELOPER EXTENSION OR OTHERWISE SHOULD SUCH PROPERTIES BE ANNEXED TO THE SILVER LAKE WATER DISTRICT.

WHEREAS, certain owners of property adjacent to the northwest boundary of the Silver Lake Water District have requested the District to support their effort to obtain sewer and water service in the near future; and

WHEREAS, these properties are presently outside the Interim Urban Growth Area for Southwest Snohomish County and are also within the boundaries of the Cross Valley Water District; and

WHEREAS, these property owners intend to obtain withdrawal from the Cross Valley Water District because that District is unable to provide sewer service in the near future; and

WHEREAS, Silver lake Water District has water and sewer facilities with sufficient capacity to extend service to these properties, by developer extension agreement or otherwise, should such properties annex to the Silver Lake Water District; and

WHEREAS, the Commissioners of the Silver Lake Water District believe that the Snohomish County Council should know that water and sewer service may be obtained by these property owners from Silver Lake Water District in the reasonably foreseeable future should such properties annex to the District.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Commissioners of the Silver Lake Water District as follows:

1. The Silver Lake Water District has water and sewer facilities in the area of properties shown on attached exhibit A. Such properties would be able to obtain water and sewer service, by developer extension agreement or otherwise, from the Silver Lake Water District should such properties be annexed to the District.

2. Should some or all of the properties set forth on exhibit A file lawful petition with the Silver Lake Water District to annex to the District, the Commissioners would review and consider such petition in good faith and based on facts as known by the Commissioners at this time would likely determine to annex these properties to the Silver Lake Water District.



PROPOSED SPANN ANNEXATION
BOUNDARY DESCRIPTION**

Beginning at the southeast corner of Lot 9 Plat of Woodridge Heights Division 1 being the true point of beginning; thence northerly along the east line of said Plat to the northeast corner of Tract 999 of said Plat; thence westerly along the north line of said Tract 999 to a point lying 800.25 feet east of the west line of Section 27, Township 28 N, Range 5 E, W.M.; thence northerly to a point on the southerly margin of 116th Street S.E. said point lying 825 feet east and 30 feet south of the northwest corner of said Section 27; thence westerly along the southerly margin of 116th Street S.E. a distance of 420 feet; thence northerly across 116th Street S.E. a distance of 60 feet to a point on the northerly margin of 116th Street S.E. said point lying 405 feet east of the west line of Section 22, Township 28 N, Range 5 E, W.M.; thence continuing northerly a distance of 400 feet to a point lying 405 feet east of the west line of said Section 22; thence westerly a distance of 405 feet to a point on the west line of said Section 22 said point lying 430 feet north of the southwest corner of said Section 22; thence northerly along the west line of said Section 22 to the northeasterly margin of Lowell-Larimer Road; thence southeasterly along said northeasterly margin of Lowell-Larimer Road to the intersection of the easterly margin of Marsh Road and East Lowell-Larimer Road; thence southerly along the easterly margin of East Lowell-Larimer Road to the intersection of the easterly margin of Seattle Hill Road; thence southwesterly along the southeasterly margin of Seattle Hill Road to the south line of Section 27, Township 28 N, Range 5 E, W.M.; thence westerly along the south line of said Section 27 to the southeast corner of Lot 9 Plat of Woodridge Heights Division 1 and the true point of beginning.
