RESOLUTION NO. 469

A RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS OF THE SILVER LAKE WATER DISTRICT SETTING THE TIME FOR COLLECTING SEWER AND WATER SERVICE RATES FROM THE CUSTOMERS OF THE DISTRICT

WHEREAS, the practice of the District has been to not bill for water and sewer service charges for newly constructed properties that are connected to the District sewer and water systems until the structures are occupied; and

WHEREAS, it has become increasingly difficult for the District to track when a newly constructed house of commercial building is occupied; and

WHEREAS, the District is losing revenue due this practice as well as to occupation and use of houses and structures without notice to the District; and

WHEREAS, this practice causes upward pressure on monthly sewer and water rates because of the lost revenue; and

WHEREAS, after due deliberation the Board of Commissioners of the Silver Lake Water District has determined to amend the practice of collection of monthly sewer and water rates of the District.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS OF THE SILVER LAKE WATER DISTRICT SNOHOMISH COUNTY, WASHINGTON AS FOLLOWS:

1. All properties within the District newly connected to water or sewer service shall be billed for monthly service charges from the date of connection to the District system(s).
2. This policy shall be effective for all properties connecting to District systems after March 31, 1997
3. Should any part or provision of this ordinance be declared by a court of competent jurisdiction to be invalid, the same shall not affect the validity of the ordinance as a whole, or any part thereof other than the part declared to be invalid.
4. Any and all resolutions of the Silver Lake Water District in conflict with the provisions of this resolution are hereby repealed.
