RESOLUTION NO. 470

A RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS OF THE SILVER LAKE WATER DISTRICT, SNOHOMISH COUNTY, WASHINGTON, ESTABLISHING NEW AND UPDATED FEES AND CHARGES FOR WATER METER INSTALLATION FOR WATER CUSTOMERS AND INSPECTION OF UTILITY DEVELOPMENT BY DISTRICT EMPLOYEES AND BY CONSULTANTS.

WHEREAS, charges for water meter installation for water customers has remained the same since 1981; and

WHEREAS, charges for inspection by District employees of utility development has remained the same since 1984; and

WHEREAS, the cost of providing these services has increased due to inflation and increased materials and equipment costs; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Commissioners have received reports from its staff and its consulting engineers, Gray & Osborne, setting forth the expected cost to provide these services.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Commissioners of the Silver Lake Water District, Snohomish County, Washington as follows:

1. Charges for water meter installations for any District customer shall conform to the following schedule:

5/8" to 3/4" drop in	\$265.00
5/8" to 3/4" full service	\$440.00
1" full service	\$515.00
1" drop in	\$315.00

provided all such installations placed over 150 feet from the District water line shall pay an additional \$300.00

2. A rate of \$37.00 per hour plus the mileage allowed by RCW 43.03.060 shall be charged the builder or developer for District personnel inspection of water and sewer utility construction in the District. Inspections done by District consultants billed to the District shall be charged at the same amount by the District to the builder or Developer plus an administration fee of \$25.00 per bill. Payment of these charges is required prior to the District allowing hook up of the District water and sewer system.

3. Charges for side sewer inspection for any District customer shall be \$150.00. Such side sewer inspection fee shall be paid prior to the inspection occurring.

4. These charges and fees shall become effective April 1,
1997.

5. The fees set forth in Sections 1 through 4 are not in lieu of any U.L.I.D. assessments, permit fees or any other fees or charges of the District heretofore or hereafter adopted.

6. Should any part or provision of this ordinance be declared by a court of competent jurisdiction to be invalid, the same shall not affect the validity of the ordinance as a whole, or any part thereof other than the part declared to be invalid.

7. Any and all resolutions of the Silver Lake Water District in conflict with the provisions of this resolution are hereby repealed.
