RESOLUTION NO. 492

A RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS OF THE SILVER LAKE WATER DISTRICT, SNOHOMISH COUNTY, WASHINGTON, ESTABLISHING NEW AND UPDATED TERMS AND PROCEDURES FOR RENTAL OF WATER METERS FROM THE DISTRICT

WHEREAS, on certain occasions the District receives requests to rent water meters and maintain such meters on hand for rental, and

WHEREAS, at times, those who rent meters fail to return the meter as required by the rental agreement, and

WHEREAS, failure to return such meters causes staff to take additional time to locate and obtain the meter to process the bill for rental of such meter, and

WHEREAS, District staff has found the present fine for failure to return the meter is often not sufficient incentive for a renter of a meter to timely return the meter, and

WHEREAS, a standard procedure, water rate and fine structure will facilitate control and regulation of meter rentals.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Commissioners of the Silver Lake Water District, Snohomish County, Washington as follows:

1. The daily rental rate for a meter is \$15.00 plus \$5.00 a day after the first day.
2. Water used through the meter shall be charged the then current rate for a single family residence.
3. Upon return, a meter shall be inspected for damages or misuse and charges will be billed accordingly.
4. No meter shall be rented to the same user more than a month without the meter being returned to the District office for inspection and billing for water used.


of \$200.00 per day. After notice, and upon prompt return the fine may be reduced to not less than \$100.00.

6. District staff is directed to write the necessary forms and rules to implement and carry out the terms of this Resolution.


7. Should any part or provision of this ordinance be declared by a court of competent jurisdiction to be invalid, the same shall not affect the validity of the ordinance as a whole, or any part thereof other than the part declared to be invalid.

8. Any and all resolutions of the Silver Lake Water District in conflict with the provisions of this resolution are hereby repealed.


