A RESOLUTION providing for a distribution system of water mains and doing all other work necessary to make a complete improvement in connection therewith, within the boundaries more fully described in the body of this Resolution, creating an assessment district, creating a Local Improvement District Fund therefor, providing that the costs and expenses of such improvement shall be paid by special assessments in ten equal annual installments under the mode of "Payment by Bonds", said bonds to bear interest at a rate not to exceed six per cent (6%) per annum.

WHEREAS, a petition signed by the owners according to the records of the County Auditor of Snohomish County of at least 51% of the area of the land within the limits of the local improvement district to be created as hereinafter described in Section 3 hereof, has been filed with the Commissioners of Silver Lake Water District, petitioning that a system of water mains be constructed, and that all necessary work in connection therewith be done to conduct water from the Silver Lake Water District water supply system to the property within the boundaries described in Section 3 hereof, all in accordance with plans and specifications submitted by the Engineer employed by the Board of Water District Commissioners, the estimated cost of such improvement being the sum of \$26,370.00; that pipes used shall be of cementasbestos or cast iron, together with all appurtenances and work incidental thereto of the approximate size in, on, along and under the following described streets, roads, alleys and easements:

> 6" pipe lines in Farmer Road from the Stock Show Road to the Brush (Brushrud) Road and in Robeck Road from the Farmer Road to its terminus.

4" pipe lines in the Brush Road and Larsen Rd. from the Farmer Road to their respective termini, and in the Farmer Road from Brush Road northerly approximately 580 feet. WHEREAS, by Resolution No. 51 a hearing was ordered on said petition to take place on the llth day of July, 1955, at 8:00 P. M. at the Leo Nelson residence on the west side of Silver Lake, and it appearing that notice of said hearing has been given to the property owners in said proposed improvement district in accordance with said resolution and Revised Code of Washington, paragraph No. 57.16.060; and

WHEREAS, after due hearing on said petition it appears to the Commissioners of said Silver Lake Water District that the petition is signed by the owners according to the records of the County Auditor of Snohomish County of at least 51% of the area of the land within the limits of the local improvement district to be created as hereinafter described in Section 3 hereof, and that public convenience and necessity require that the above mentioned improvements be made; NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS OF SILVER LAKE WATER DISTRICT, Snohomish County, Washington:

Section 1: That all of the territory within the boundaries described in Section 3 of this Resolution be improved by the construction and installation of a distribution system of water mains, and that all work in connection therewith be done necessary to conduct water from the Silver Lake Water District water supply system to all of the property described in Section 3 of this Resolution, and that said water distribution system be constructed according to plans and specifications prepared under the direction of the Engineer employed by said Water District Commissioners for such purpose, which plans and specifications are hereby adopted and approved, the estimated cost of such improvement being the sum of \$26,370.00 to be paid by the Local Improvement District. That detailed plans of said proposed improvement are hereby adopted, are attached hereto, marked Exhibit "A" and hereby made a part hereof.

Section 2: That all of the costs and expenses of such improvement shall be borne by and assessed against the property included in the assessment district herein created, except the additional cost of a six inch (6") line over a four inch (4") line on <u>Mobeck</u> will be borne by the entire water district. Special assessments shall be levied against the property situated within such Local Improvement District in proportion to the special benefits to be derived by the property in such Local Improvement District from such improvement, the mode of assessment shall be such as may be determined by the Commissioners of the Water District and without regard to the zone and termini method provided for in laws of 1947, Chapter 155, Section 1, Page 717.

Section 3: That there is hereby established a Local Improvement District to be called Local Improvement District No. 6 which shall include the property described as follows:

> Beginning at a point on the North line of Section 19, Township 28 N.R. 5 E.W.M., 608.164 feet East of the Northwest corner of said section; thence proceeding East along said North line to the North Quarter corner of said section; thence South along the North-South center line to the South line of the North Half of the Southwest Quarter of Section 19; thence West to the Southwest corner of the East half of the Northwest Quarter of the Southwest Quarter Section 19; thence North along the West line of the East half of the West half of the West line of the East half of the West half of the West half, Section 19 to the point of beginning, situate in Snohomish County, Washington.

Section 4: A special fund is hereby created to be called Local Improvement District Fund No. 6 Construction Fund, which shall consist in the aggregate of the several amounts assessed, levied and collected on the lots, tracts, parcels of land and other property in said Local Improvement District, and the proceeds of the sale of the bonds of said District, for the purpose of defraying the costs and expenses of such improvement as outlined in Section 2 herein. Out of said fund shall be paid the warrants, interest thereon, and the cost of the improvement herein provided for.

Section 5: That the costs and expenses of such improvement shall be defrayed by special assessments, payable in ten equal annual installments with interest thereon at a rate not to exceed six per cent (6%) per annum, under the mode of "Payment by Bonds" as provided by law. Bonds bearing interest at a rate not to exceed six per cent

(6%) per annum, payable on or before twelve years from date of issue shall be issued in payment of said costs and expenses above mentioned.
