A RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS OF THE SILVER LAKE WATER DISTRICT, SNOHOMISH COUNTY, WASHINGTON, ADOPTING NEW AND UPDATED SILVER LAKE WATER DISTRICT CROSS CONNECTION CONTROL MANUAL

BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Commissioners of the Silver Lake Water District, Snohomish County, Washington as follows:

SECTION 1. ADOPTION OF CROSS CONNECTION CONTROL MANUAL

Having reviewed and considered a new and updated Cross Connection Control Manual prepared by District staff, the Board of Commissioners hereby adopt the Cross Connection Control Manual dated August 2003.

Section 2: AMENDMENT OF SECTION 2 OF RESOLUTION 511

Section 2 of Resolution 511 adopted on March 24 2000 is hereby repealed and amended to read as follows:

The control, including elimination, of cross connections for all new and existing water service customers shall be in accordance with the Silver Lake Water District's Cross Connection Control Manual dated August 2003, attached hereto and incorporated by reference herein. In addition, applicable regulations of the Department of Health stated in the State of Washington Administrative Code (WAC 246-290-490) or subsequent revisions or reenactments, shall be complied with. Where, in a specific case, different materials, methods or other requirements apply, the more restrictive shall govern. Where there is a conflict between a general requirement and a specific requirement the specific requirement shall govern.

Section 3: Severability. If any section, subsection, sentence, clause, phrase or word of this Resolution should be held to be invalid or unconstitutional by a court of competent jurisdiction, such invalidity or unconstitutionality thereof shall not affect the validity or constitutionality of any other section, subsection, sentence, clause, phrase or word of this Resolution.
