RESOLUTION NO. 562

A RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS OF THE SILVER LAKE WATER DISTRICT, SNOHOMISH COUNTY, WASHINGTON, ADOPTING THE UPDATED WASTEWATER SYSTEM COMPREHENSIVE PLAN DATED AUGUST 2003.

BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Commissioners of the Silver Lake Water District, Snohomish County, Washington as follows:

WHEREAS, State law requires the District to update its Waste Water System Comprehensive Plan on a periodic basis; and

WHEREAS, after due notice the Commissioners held a public hearing on August 28, 2003 and took testimony on the Waste Water Comprehensive Plan dated August 2003; and

WHEREAS, such updated plan will be circulated to state and local officials for review and comment on this newly updated plan; and

WHEREAS, Gray & Osborne have presented progress reports on the work to update the Waste Water Comprehensive Plan to the Commissioners and the Commissioners have reviewed the Plan.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED THAT:

1. The Commissioners of the Silver Lake Water District hereby adopt the newly updated Waste Water Comprehensive Plan of the Silver Lake Water District dated August 2003 and designated as G&O No. 02775. Such Plan consists of one volume.
2. The Commissioners hereby direct staff to present the adopted Waste Water Comprehensive Plan to state and local officials for review and comment in accordance with state law.
