A RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS OF THE SILVER LAKE WATER DISTRICT, SNOHOMISH COUNTY, WASHINGTON, ADOPTING WATER RATES FOR WHOLESALE CUSTOMERS OF THE DISTRICT AND SEWER RATES FOR INDIVIDUAL SEWER CUSTOMERS OF THE DISTRICT LOCATED OUTSIDE THE CORPORATE BOUNDARIES OF THE SILVER LAKE WATER DISTRICT AND ESTABLISHING GENERAL FACILITY CHARGES TO BE PAID BY PROPERTY LOCATED OUTSIDE THE CORPORATE BOUNDARIES OF THE DISTRICT AS A CONDITION TO USE OF SILVER LAKE WATER AND SEWER INFRASTRUCTURE

WHEREAS, the District has an interlocal agreement with Cross Valley Water District (CVWD) to provide water to Cross Valley on an interim basis for water customers served by CVWD located within the service area defined in the interlocal agreement (Service Area); and

WHEREAS, the interlocal agreement provides for the District to provide sewer service to customers located within the Service Area; and

WHEREAS, development of water and sewer systems in the Service Area has occurred; and

WHEREAS, properties receiving water and sewer service in the Service Area use and are benefited by general facilities of the District's water and sewer system; and

WHEREAS, such properties would not be developed at this time without use of District general facilities downstream from such properties; and

WHEREAS, water and sewer rates and charges are needed for these classes of District customer; and

WHEREAS, The rates and charges set forth in this resolution shall be considered rates and charges for the sewer and water utilities for wholesale water customers and individual water and sewer customers outside the District Corporate boundaries. It is found and declared that the classifications, rates and charges set forth herein are fair and equitable.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Commissioners of the Silver Lake Water District, Snohomish County, Washington as follows:

1. <u>FINDINGS</u> The Commissioners adopt as findings the preceding recitals to this Resolution.

2. <u>ADOPTION OF RATES FOR WHOLESALE WATER CUSTOMERS</u> The following rates for Wholesale Water Customers are hereby adopted effective July 1, 2004.

Master Meters.

a. Master meter rates shall be required for water districts, and any other municipal water purveyor purchasing water from the District.

 b. The consumption charges for master meters shall be as follows: Meter Charge \$150.00 monthly Water Charge (exclusive of meter charge) \$1.71 per 100 cu. ft.

3. <u>ADOPTION OF RATES FOR INDIVIDUAL SEWER CUSTOMERS</u> <u>LOCATED OUTSIDE THE CORPORATE BOUNDARIES OF THE DISTRICT</u> The following rates for individual sewer customers located outside the Corporate boundaries of the District are hereby adopted August 20, 2004.

Sewer flow for industrial)

4. <u>General Facility Charges</u> Properties outside the Corporate boundaries of the District using or benefiting from the District water and sewer general facilities shall pay a General Facility Charge of \$4608.86 per equivalent residential unit to the District as a condition of water and sewer service by either Cross Valley Water District or Silver Lake Water District.

5. State utility tax

The General Manager is authorized to increase or decrease the water or sewer charges herein to reflect any change in the state of Washington tax on water or sewer system revenues.

6. OTHER CHARGES ASSESSMENTS AND FEES

The rates and charges set forth herein are not in lieu of any U.L.I.D. assessments, permit fees, or any other fees or charges of the District heretofore or hereafter adopted that are applicable to the properties subject to this resolution.

7. <u>SEVERABILITY</u>: Should any part or provision of this resolution be declared by a court of competent jurisdiction to be invalid, the same shall not affect the validity of the resolution as a whole, or any part thereof other than the part declared to be invalid.
