

SILVER LAKE WATER DISTRICT
Snohomish County, Washington
Resolution No. 64

A RESOLUTION providing for a distribution system of water mains and doing all other work necessary to make a complete improvement in connection therewith, within the boundaries more fully described in the body of this Resolution, creating an assessment district, creating a Local Improvement District Fund therefor, providing that the costs and expenses of such improvement shall be paid by special assessments in ten equal annual installments under the mode of "Payment by Bonds", said bonds to bear interest at a rate not to exceed six per cent (6%) per annum.

WHEREAS, a Resolution of Intention was passed by the Commissioners of Silver Lake Water District on the 12th day of September, 1955 providing that a system of water mains be constructed, and that all necessary work in connection therewith be done to conduct water from the Silver Lake Water supply system to the property within the boundaries described in Section 3 hereof, all in accordance with plans and specifications submitted by the Engineer employed by the Board of Water District Commissioners, the estimated cost of such improvement being the sum of \$32,100.00; that pipes used shall be of cement-asbestos or cast iron, together with all appurtenances and work incidental thereto of the approximate size in, on, along and under the following described streets, roads, alleys and easements:

six-inch pipe lines in Second Avenue East from the Stock Show Road south to Walton's Folly Road; thence east to Silver Way and south to West Second Place.

Four-inch pipe lines in 113th Street Southwest and 115th Street Southwest in Plat of Silver Acres; also in West First Place, West Second Place, Walton's Folly Road east of Silver Way, Power Place, Silver Way south of West Second Place in Plat of Silver Acres No. 2; also in Meridian Avenue north from Stock Show Road, First Avenue East to south line Tract 34, First Avenue West to south line Tract 19 in Berg's Addition.

The water lines are to be installed as described above together with the necessary gate valves, pressure reducing valves and appurtenances for the best operation of the water system as determined by

the District Engineer employed by the Water District.

The District shall construct and install 4-inch standard fire hydrants in connection with the acquisition and construction of the water district lines throughout the District to be located in accordance with the requirements of the Washington Surveying and Rating Bureau for Zone 1 insurance rating wherever feasible.

WHEREAS, by Resolution No. 59, a hearing was ordered on said petition to take place on the 10th day of October, 1955, at 8:00 P.M. at the Leo Nelson residence on the west side of Silver Lake, and it appearing that notice of said hearing has been given to the property owners in said proposed improvement district in accordance with said resolution and Revised Code of Washington, paragraph No. 57.16.060;

WHEREAS, after due hearing on said petition it appears to the Commissioners of said Silver Lake Water District that the owners of less than 40% of the area of the land within the limits of the local improvement district to be created as hereinafter described in Section 3 thereof have objected in writing to such improvement and that public convenience and necessity require that the above mentioned improvements be made; NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS OF SILVER LAKE WATER DISTRICT, Snohomish County, Washington:

Section 1: That all of the territory within the boundaries described in Section 3 of this Resolution be improved by the construction and installation of a distribution system of water mains, and that all work in connection therewith be done necessary to conduct water from the Silver Lake Water District water supply system to all of the property described in Section 3 of this Resolution, and that said water distribution system be constructed according to plans and specifications prepared under the direction of the Engineer employed by said Water District Commissioners for such purpose, which plans and specifications are hereby adopted and approved, the estimated cost of such improvement being the sum of \$32,100.00 to be paid by the Local Improvement District. That detailed plans of said proposed improvement are hereby adopted, are attached hereto, marked Exhibit "A" and hereby made a part hereof.

Section 2: That all of the costs and expenses of such im-

provement shall be borne by and assessed against the property included in the assessment district herein created. Special assessments shall be levied against the property situated within such Local Improvement District in proportion to the special benefits to be derived by the property in such Local Improvement District from such improvement, the mode of assessment shall be such as may be determined by the Commissioners of the Water District and without regard to the zone and termini method provided for in laws of 1947, Chapter 155, Section 1, Page 717.

Section 3: That there is hereby established a Local Improvement District to be called Local Improvement District No. 7 which shall include the property described as follows:

Beginning at the Northeast corner SE $\frac{1}{4}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$ Section 24, Township 28 North, Range 4 East, W.M.; thence South along the East line of Section 24 to the Southeast corner thereof; thence East along the North line of Section 30, Township 28 North, Range 5 East, a distance of 1666.71' to intersection with the westerly line of the Puget Sound Power & Light Co. right-of-way; thence South 40° 25' 25" West along said right-of-way line to intersection with the West line of said Section 30; thence North along said West line of Section 30 to the Northwest corner thereof; thence West along the South line of Section 24, Township 28 North, Range 4 East to the Southwest corner of SE $\frac{1}{4}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$ of said Section 24; thence North to the Northwest corner SE $\frac{1}{4}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$ Section 24, being the centerline of the Silver Lake Road; thence East along the centerline of the Silver Lake Road to the Point of Beginning. The area described encompasses the Plats of Silver Acres Nos. 1 and 2, situate in Snohomish County, Washington; also the E $\frac{1}{2}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$ and W $\frac{1}{2}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$ of Section 24, Township 28 North, Range 4 E.W.M.,

Section 4: A special fund is hereby created to be called Local Improvement District Fund No. 7 Construction Fund, which shall consist in the aggregate of the several amounts assessed, levied and collected on the lots, tracts, parcels of land and other property in said Local Improvement District, and the proceeds of the sale of the bonds of said District, for the purpose of defraying the costs and expenses of such improvement as outlined in Section 2 herein. Out of said fund shall be paid the warrants, interest thereon, and the cost of the improvement herein provided for.

Section 5: That the costs and expenses of such improvement shall be defrayed by special assessments, payable in ten equal annual installments with interest thereon at a rate not to exceed six per cent (6%) per annum, under the mode of "Payment by Bonds" as provided

by law. Bonds bearing interest at a rate not to exceed six per cent (6%) per annum, payable on or before twelve years from date of issue shall be issued in payment of said costs and expenses above mentioned.
