## SILVER LAKE WATER DISTRICT SNOHOMISH COUNTY, WASHINGTON RESOLUTION NO. 6//

A RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS OF THE SILVER LAKE WATER DISTRICT, SNOHOMISH COUNTY, WASHINGTON, CHANGING AND ESTABLISHING COLLECTION OF NEW REQUIRED SEWER GENERAL FACILITY CHARGES AND FORWARDING SAME TO ALDERWOOD WATER AND WASTEWATER IN ACCORDANCE WITH A NEW INTERLOCAL AGREEMENT WITH AWWD FOR PROPERTIES LOCATED WITHIN THE ALDERWOOD DRAINAGE BASIN

WHEREAS, Silver Lake Water District (SLWD) and Alderwood Water and Wastewater District (AWWD) have each respectively revoked and rescinded an interlocal agreement dated June 13, 1996 providing for AWWD accepting sewage flows from certain areas within SLWD; and

WHEREAS, the districts have entered into a new interlocal agreement replacing the agreement dated June 13, 1996; and

WHEREAS, the new agreement dated July 21, 2006 provides for collection of AWWD's sewer connection charges in place at the time of connection for properties in SLWD that use AWWD's sewer system for transmission to King County Metro; and

WHEREAS, AWWD has recently changed its sewer connection charge and in accordance with the new interlocal agreement SLWD is responsible to collect this charge and remit it to AWWD; and

WHEREAS, this sewer connection charge may change over time;

- 1. FINDINGS The Commissioners adopt as findings the preceding recitals to this Resolution.
- 2. Administrative Procedures District staff is authorized and directed to implement procedures to collect from each property within the Alderwood drainage basin newly connecting to the SLWD sewer system any and all charges required by the AWWD-SLWD Interlocal Agreement dated July 21, 2006 at the time of such connection and remit the same to AWWD.
- 3. OTHER CHARGES ASSESSMENTS AND FEES The charges provided for in this resolution are not in lieu of any U.L.I.D. assessments, permit fees or any other fees or charges of the District heretofore or hereafter adopted.

- 4. EFFECTIVE DATE The provisions of this resolution shall be effective the date set forth below. All prior and existing District resolutions, policies and procedures relating to the charges and fees set forth in this resolution are hereby revised, modified and superseded to be in accordance with the charges and fees set forth herein.
- 5. SEVERABILITY Should any part or provision of this resolution be declared by a court of competent jurisdiction to be invalid, the same shall not affect the validity of the resolution as a whole, or any part thereof other than the part declared to be invalid.
