RESOLUTION NO. 612**

**A RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS OF THE SILVER LAKE WATER DISTRICT, SNOHOMISH COUNTY, WASHINGTON, AUTHORIZING THE DISTRICT GENERAL MANAGER TO SIGN THE WATER AND SEWER MUTUAL AID AGREEMENT DATED AUGUST 14, 2006 FOR THE PROVISION OF PERSONNEL, MATERIALS AND EQUIPMENT TO OTHER WATER AND SEWER UTILITIES IN SNOHOMISH COUNTY WHO ARE PARTIES TO THE SAME AGREEMENT AND WHO REQUEST ASSISTANCE TO HANDLE A DISASTER OR EMERGENCY**

**WHEREAS, on July 13, 1995 the District adopted Resolution No.456 which authorized the General Manager to sign the Sewer and Water Mutual Aid Agreement for the provision of personnel and equipment in disasters and emergencies; and**

**WHEREAS, the General Manager of the District signed the Sewer and Water Mutual Aid Agreement; and**

**WHEREAS, signatories to the Sewer and Water Mutual Aid Agreement (developed in 1995) have jointly proposed language revisions to clarify the terms and conditions for their existing Sewer and Water Mutual Aid Agreement; and**

**WHEREAS, the Board of Commissioners has the power and authority to approve the signing of Water and Sewer Mutual Aid Agreement – 2006, for the purpose of providing personnel, materials and equipment to other water and sewer utilities (Purveyors) of Snohomish County who are parties to this Agreement and who request assistance to handle a disaster or emergency; and**

**WHEREAS, the Board of Commissioners reviewed the Water and Sewer Mutual Aid Agreement – 2006 and authorized the District General Manager to sign it by adopting Resolution 610 on July 10, 2006; and**

**WHEREAS, Representatives of the City of Everett have circulated an edited Sewer and Water Mutual Aid Agreement correcting typos and with new language clarifying language set forth in Paragraph 6 of the July agreement and requesting this new agreement dated August 14, 2006 be signed and implemented by the District; and**

**WHEREAS, the Board of Commissioners have reviewed the new Water and Sewer Mutual Aid Agreement dated August 14, 2006, attached hereto as Exhibit A (which document is made a part hereof by this reference); and**

WHEREAS, the Board of Commissioners finds that it is in the best interest of the Silver Lake Water District and its system customers to secure participation in mutual aid with other Purveyors of Snohomish County for responding to disasters and emergencies with the updated and improved language;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Commissioners, as follows:


1. The Board of Commissioners approve and the General Manager is authorized to sign the Water and Sewer Mutual Aid Agreement dated August 14, 2006 attached to this resolution.
2. The authorization of the Water and Sewer Mutual Aid Agreement dated August 14, 2006 shall immediately supersede and rescind the Silver Lake Water District's prior signatory to the Sewer and Water Mutual Aid Agreement in July 2006 as well as the agreement developed and signed in 1995.
3. The General Manager is directed and authorized to send a certified copy of this resolution to the Everett Utilities Director.
