

**RESOLUTION FOR THE ADOPTION OF THE
SNOHOMISH COUNTY 2010 NATURAL HAZARDS MITIGATION PLAN
UPDATE**

Resolution No. 656

WHEREAS, all of Snohomish County has exposure to natural hazards that increase the risk to life, property, environment and the County's economy;

WHEREAS; pro-active mitigation of known hazards before a disaster event can reduce or eliminate long-term risk to life and property;

WHEREAS, The Disaster Mitigation Act of 2000 (Public Law 106-390) established new requirements for pre and post disaster hazard mitigation programs;


WHEREAS; a coalition of Snohomish County, Cities and Special Purpose Districts with like planning objectives has been formed to pool resources and create consistent mitigation strategies within the county;

WHEREAS, the coalition has completed a planning process that engages the public, assesses the risk and vulnerability to the impacts of natural hazards, develops a mitigation strategy consistent with a set of uniform goals and objectives, and creates an updated plan for implementing, evaluating and revising this strategy;

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Commissioners of the Silver Lake Water & Sewer District, Snohomish County, Washington as follows:

- 1.) The Board of Commissioners adopts in its entirety, Volume 1 and parts 1, the Silver Lake Water and Sewer District jurisdictional annex of Volume 2, and the appendices of Volume 2 of the July 2010 Update Snohomish County Natural Hazards Mitigation Plan (SCNHMP).
- 2.) The District will use the adopted portions of the SCNHMP to guide pre and post disaster mitigation of the hazards identified.
- 3.) The District will coordinate the strategies identified in the SCNHMP with other planning programs and mechanisms under its jurisdictional authority.
- 4.) The District will continue its support of the Steering Committee and continue to participate in the Coalition Partnership as described by the SCNHMP.
- 5.) The District will help to promote and support the mitigation successes of all SCNHMP Coalition Partners.


