A RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS OF THE SILVER LAKE WATER AND SEWER DISTRICT, SNOHOMISH COUNTY, WASHINGTON, ESTABLISHING AND UPDATING SAFETY POLICIES FOR SILVER LAKE WATER AND SEWER DISTRICT EMPLOYEES.

WHEREAS, the Commissioners of Silver Lake Water and Sewer District are required to comply with Occupational Safety and Health Act (OSHA) and Washington Industrial Safety and (Health Act) laws and regulations concerning workplace health and safety; and

WHEREAS, all District employees are required to comply with safety requirements pertaining to their job duties; and

WHEREAS, the Silver Lake Water and Sewer District is committed to providing a safe and healthy work environment for its employees; and

WHEREAS, the District recognizes the need for development of safe working practices for every employee and desires to promote on-the-job safety by encouraging the proper use of equipment, tools, and other devices; and

WHEREAS, the District has recently participated in a Washington State Department of Labor and Industries audit of facilities and safety programs; and

WHEREAS, over the last year District staff have reviewed consolidated, updated and reorganized the existing District Safety Policy Manual and presented the 2011 Safety Policy Manual to the Commissioners for their review which includes the following safety policies and programs:

- A. Arc Welding
- B. Back Injury Prevention
- C. Bloodborne Pathogens
- D. Confined Space Program
- E. Defensive Driving Program
- F. Excavation Safety
- G. Fall Protection

- H. Hearing Conservation
- I. Heat Stress
- J. Ladder Safety
- K. Lock/Tag Out Program
- L. MSDS Material Data Safety Sheets
- M. Personal Safety & Terrorism
- N. Work Zone/Traffic Control; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS OF SILVER LAKE WATER AND SEWER DISTRICT, Snohomish County, Washington:

1. FINDINGS: The Commissioners adopt as findings the preceding recitals to this Resolution.
2. The 2011 Safety Policy Manual dated October 2011 is hereby approved and adopted effective the date set forth below.
3. The Silver Lake Water and Sewer District staff are hereby authorized and directed to write and update from time to time documents, specifications for operation and procedures found in the 2011 Plan with the goal of maintaining and improving it to help implement and effectuate these policies and programs. Such updates shall be reported to the Commissioners.
