RESOLUTION NO. 705

A RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS OF SILVER LAKE WATER AND SEWER DISTRICT, SNOHOMISH COUNTY, WASHINGTON, ADOPTING AN EMERGENCY RESPONSE PLAN OF THE DISTRICT'S WATER, SEWER, AND CYBER FACILITIES.

WHEREAS, the Silver Lake Water and Sewer District (“District”) is a municipal corporation providing water and sewer utility services pursuant to Title 57 RCW; and

WHEREAS, the Public Health Security and Bioterrorism Preparedness and Response Act of 2002 (the “Act”) states that a community water system that serves a population of greater than 3,300 people must review the vulnerability of its system to a terrorist attack or other intentional acts intended to substantially disrupt the ability of the system to provide a safe and reliable supply of drinking water; and

WHEREAS, the District initiated the preparation of an Emergency Response Plan as required by the Act and retained Gray & Osborne, Inc., an engineering and planning consultant (“Consultant”), to prepare an Emergency Response Plan for the District water, sewer, and cyber facilities; and

WHEREAS, working with key District staff, the Consultant completed and provided to the District an Emergency Response Plan dated December 2004; and

WHEREAS, District staff and the Consultant have worked together to update and amend the District’s Emergency Response Plan; and

WHEREAS, this work has resulted in a finished/updated Emergency Response Plan identified as Silver Lake Water and Sewer District Emergency Response Plan (G&O #10531) dated May 2014 (Emergency Response Plan); and


WHEREAS, the Emergency Response Plan is exempt from public inspection and copying, pursuant to the provisions of RCW 42.56.420; and 5 U.S.C. 552b(c)(3) and Section 143 (a)(3) of the Safe Drinking Water Act (Title XIV of the Public Health Services Act); now, therefore

BE IT RESOLVED, by the Board of Commissioners of Silver Lake Water and Sewer District, Snohomish County, Washington, as follows:

1. The Emergency Response Plan is hereby approved and adopted effective the date set forth below.

2. The Emergency Response Plan shall be exempt from public inspection and copying, pursuant to RCW 42.56.420, and 5 USC 552b (c)(3) and Section 1433 (a)(3) of the Safe Drinking Water Act (Title XIV of the Public Health Services Act) and shall not be made available for public distribution in accordance with the exemptions in such statutes.
3. The General Manager and his/her designees are directed and authorized to update the Emergency Response Plan to maintain current contact information, improve operational response to emergencies, train staff, or as mandated by State or Federal law.
