RESOLUTION NO. 749**

A RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS OF THE SILVER LAKE WATER AND SEWER DISTRICT, SNOHOMISH COUNTY, WASHINGTON, AWARDED THE RESERVOIR NO. 3 IMPROVEMENT PROJECT TO RAZZ CONSTRUCTION, INC.

WHEREAS, RCW 57.08.050 requires that the District Commissioners let contracts for Public Work in excess of \$50,000 go through a competitive bidding process; and

WHEREAS, the District received bids for the Reservoir No. 3 Improvement Project, and the apparent low bid was submitted by Razz Construction, Inc. in the amount of \$3,262,516.40; and

WHEREAS, District staff and Engineer have completed the review of Razz Construction Inc. qualifications, and Razz Construction, Inc. is currently a Washington State registered and licensed contractor and appears to have the relevant qualifications and experience to successfully perform the work that the project will require; and

WHEREAS, the General Manager recommends that the District award the Reservoir No. 3 Improvement Project to Razz Construction, Inc. as the lowest responsive responsible bidder.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED THAT:

1. The Reservoir No. 3 Improvement Project is hereby awarded to Razz Construction, Inc. as the lowest responsible bidder with the bid of \$3,262,516.40 including sales tax; and
2. Curt Brees, the District's General Manager, is hereby authorized to execute the Contract on behalf of the District as appropriate; and
3. Curt Brees, the District General Manager, is hereby authorized to issue a Notice to Proceed to Razz Construction, Inc. as appropriate.
