RESOLUTION NO. 778**

A RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS OF THE SILVER LAKE WATER AND SEWER DISTRICT, SNOHOMISH COUNTY, WASHINGTON, AWARDING THE 131st STREET WATER MAIN REPLACEMENT PROJECT TO D&G BACKHOE, INC.

WHEREAS, RCW 57.08.050 requires that the District's Commissioners let contracts for Public Work in excess of \$50,000 go through a competitive bidding process; and

WHEREAS, the District received bids for the 131st Street Water Main Replacement Project on August 6, 2019, and the apparent low bid was submitted by D&G Backhoe, Inc., in the amount of \$234,344.98 including sales tax; and

WHEREAS, District staff and Engineer have completed the review of D&G Backhoe, Inc. qualifications, and D&G Backhoe, Inc. is currently a Washington State registered and licensed contractor and appears to have the relevant qualifications and experience to successfully perform the work that the project will require; and

WHEREAS, the General Manager recommends that the District award the 131st Street Water Main Replacement Project to D&G Backhoe, Inc. as the lowest responsive, responsible bidder.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED THAT:

1. The 131st Street Water Main Replacement Project is hereby awarded to D&G Backhoe, Inc. as the lowest responsive, responsible bidder with the bid of \$234,344.98 including sales tax; and
2. Curt Brees, the District's General Manager, is hereby authorized to execute the Contract on behalf of the District as appropriate; and
3. Curt Brees, the District General Manager, is hereby authorized to issue a Notice to Proceed to D&G Backhoe, Inc. as appropriate.


