2 A RESOLUTION providing for a distribution system of
3 water mains and doing all other work necessary to make a complete
4 improvement in connection therewith, within the boundaries more fully
5 described in the body of this Resolution, creating an assessment
6 district, creating a Local Improvement District Fund therefor, pro-
7 viding that the costs and expenses of such improvement shall be paid
8 by special assessments in ten equal annual installments under the mode
9 of "Payment by Bonds", said bonds to bear interest at a rate not to
10 exceed six per cent (6%) per annum.

12 WHEREAS, a Resolution of Intention was passed by the
13 Commissioners of Silver Lake Water District on the 8th day of July,
14 1957, providing that a system of water mains be constructed, and that
15 all necessary work in connection therewith be done to conduct water
16 from the Silver Lake Water supply system to the property within the
17 boundaries described in Section 3 hereof, all in accordance with plans
18 and specifications submitted by the Engineer employed by the Board
19 of Water District Commissioners, the estimated cost of such improvement
20 being the sum of \$15,200.00; that pipes used shall be of cement-asbestos
21 or cast iron, together with all appurtenances and work incidental
22 thereto of the approximate size in, on, along and under the following
23 described streets, roads, alleys and easements:

24 Permanent type pipe with four inch hydrants and other
25 necessary appurtenances in the streets of that portion
26 of Silver Acres #5 lying south of the East-West center
27 line of Section 30, Township 28, Range 5 East, as follows:

28 six inch pipe in Andrew Sater Road, 9th Place, 10th Place,
29 and Watt's Road from Andrew Sater Road to 9th Place; four
30 inch in 8th Place, eight inch in Watt's Road from 9th
Place to 10th Place.

The water lines are to be installed as described above
together with the necessary gate valves, pressure reducing valves
and appurtenances for the best operation of the water system as

determined by the District Engineer employed by the Water District.

1 The District shall construct and install 4-inch standard
2 fire hydrants in connection with the acquisition and construction of
3 the water district lines throughout the District to be located in
4 accordance with the requirements of the Washington Surveying and Rating
5 Bureau for Zone 1 insurance rating wherever feasible.

6 WHEREAS, by Resolution No. 78 a hearing was ordered on
7 said petition to take place on the 26th day of July, 1957, at 8:00
8 P.M. at the Leo Nelson residence on the west side of Silver Lake,
9 and it appearing that notice of said hearing has been given to the
10 property owners in said proposed improvement district in accordance
11 with said resolution and Revised Code of Washington, paragraph No.
12 57:16.060;

13 WHEREAS, after due hearing on said petition it appears to
14 the Commissioners of said Silver Lake Water District that public
15 convenience and necessity require that the above mentioned improvements
16 be made; NOW, THEREFORE,

17 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS OF SILVER LAKE
18 WATER DISTRICT, Snohomish County, Washington:

19 Section 1: That all of the territory within the boundaries
20 described in Section 3 of this Resolution be improved by the construc-
21 tion and installation of a distribution system of water mains, and
22 that all work in connection therewith be done necessary to conduct
23 water from the Silver Lake Water District water supply system to all
24 of the property described in Section 3 of this Resolution, and that
25 said water distribution system be constructed according to plans and
26 specifications prepared under the direction of the Engineer employed
27 by said Water District Commissioners for such purpose, which plans
28 and specifications are hereby adopted and approved, the estimated cost
29 of such improvement being the sum of \$15,200.00 to be paid by the
30 Local Improvement District. That detailed plans of said proposed
improvement are hereby adopted, are attached hereto, marked "Exhibit
A" and hereby made a part hereof.

1 Section 2: That all of the costs and expenses of such im-
2 provement shall be borne by and assessed against the property
3 included in the assessment district herein created. Special assessments
4 shall be levied against the property situated within such Local
5 Improvement District in proportion to the special benefits to be
6 derived by the property in such Local Improvement District from
7 such improvement, the mode of assessment shall be such as may be
8 determined by the Commissioners of the Water District and without
9 regard to the zone and termini method provided for in laws of 1947,
10 Chapter 155, Section 1, Page 717.

11 Section 3: That there is hereby established a Local Im-
12 provement District to be called Local Improvement District No. 11
13 which shall include the property described as follows:

14 Beginning at the center of Section 30, Township 28 North,
15 Range 5 East; thence west along the center line of Section
16 30 to the northwest corner of the NE $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$ of said Section
17 30; thence south to the southwest corner of the NW $\frac{1}{4}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$,
18 SW $\frac{1}{4}$; thence east to the southeast corner of said NW $\frac{1}{4}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$
19 SW $\frac{1}{4}$; thence south a distance of 180.0 feet; thence east on
20 a line parallel to and 180 feet distant from the north line
21 of the SE $\frac{1}{4}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$ Section 30 to intersection with the North-
22 South center line of Section 30; thence north along said
23 center line to point of beginning, situate in Snohomish
24 County, State of Washington.

25 Section 4: A special fund is hereby created to be called
26 Local Improvement District Fund No. 11 Construction Fund, which shall
27 consist in the aggregate of the several amounts assessed, levied and
28 collected on the lots, tracts, parcels of land and other property in
29 said Local Improvement District, and the proceeds of the sale of the
30 bonds of said District, for the purpose of defraying the costs and
expenses of such improvement as outlined in Section 2 herein. Out of
said fund shall be paid the warrants, interest thereon, and the cost
of the improvement herein provided for.

Section 5: That the costs and expenses of such improvement
shall be defrayed by special assessments, payable in ten equal annual
installments with interest thereon at a rate not to exceed six per
cent (6%) per annum, under the mode of "Payment by Bonds" as provided
