2 A RESOLUTION providing for a distribution system of
3 water mains and doing all other work necessary to make a complete
4 improvement in connection therewith, within the boundaries more fully
5 described in the body of this Resolution, creating an assessment
6 district, creating a Local Improvement District Fund therefor, pro-
7 viding that the costs and expenses of such Improvement shall be paid
8 by special assessments in ten equal annual installments under the mode
9 of "Payment by Bonds", said bonds to bear interest at a rate not to
10 exceed six per cent (6%) per annum.

11 WHEREAS, a Resolution of Intention was passed by the
12 Commissioners of Silver Lake Water District on the 8th day of July,
13 1957, providing that a system of water mains be constructed, and that
14 all necessary work in connection therewith be done to conduct water
15 from the Silver Lake Water supply system to the property within the
16 boundaries described in Section 3 hereof, all in accordance with plans
17 and specifications submitted by the Engineer employed by the Board
18 of Water District Commissioners, the estimated cost of such improvement
19 being the sum of \$6610.00; that pipes used shall be of cement-
20 asbestos or cast iron, together with all appurtenances and work
21 incidental thereto of the approximate size in, on, along and under the
22 following described streets, roads, alleys and easements:

23 Six inch permanent type pipe with 4 inch hydrants
24 and other necessary appurtenances in the Green
25 Lantern Road from the northeast corner of Plat
of Strait's Addition to the Thomas Lake Road
Intersection.

26 The water lines are to be installed as described above
27 together with the necessary gate valves, pressure reducing valves
28 and appurtenances for the best operation of the water system as
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determined by the District Engineer employed by the Water District.

1 The District shall construct and install 4-inch standard
2 fire hydrants in connection with the acquisition and construction of
3 the water district lines throughout the District to be located in
4 accordance with the requirements of the Washington Surveying and
5 Rating Bureau for Zone 1 insurance rating wherever feasible.

6 WHEREAS, by Resolution No. 79 a hearing was ordered on said
7 petition to take place on the 26th day of July, 1957, at 8:00 P.M.
8 at the Leo Nelson residence on the west side of Silver Lake, and it
9 appearing that notice of said hearing has been given to the property
10 owners in said proposed improvement district in accordance with said
11 resolution and Revised Code of Washington, paragraph No. 57.16.060;

12 WHEREAS, after due hearing on said petition it appears to
13 the Commissioners of said Silver Lake Water District that public
14 convenience and necessity require that the above mentioned improvements
15 be made; NOW, THEREFORE,

16 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS OF SILVER LAKE
17 WATER DISTRICT, Snohomish County, Washington:

18 Section 1: That all of the territory within the boundaries
19 described in Section 3 of this Resolution be improved by the construction
20 and installation of a distribution system of water mains, and that all
21 work in connection therewith be done necessary to conduct water from
22 the Silver Lake Water District water supply system to all of the
23 property described in Section 3 of this Resolution, and that said water
24 distribution system be constructed according to plans and specifica-
25 tions prepared under the direction of the Engineer employed by said
26 Water District Commissioners for such purpose, which plans and
27 specifications are hereby adopted and approved, the estimated cost of
28 such improvement being the sum of \$6610.00 to be paid by the Local
29 Improvement District. That detailed plans of said proposed improvement
30 are hereby adopted, are attached hereto, marked "Exhibit A" and hereby

made a part hereof.

1 Section 2: That all of the costs and expenses of such im-
2 provement shall be borne by and assessed against the property
3 included in the assessment district herein created. Special assessments
4 shall be levied against the property situated within such Local Im-
5 provement District in proportion to the special benefits to be derived
6 by the property in such Local Improvement District from such improvement
7 the mode of assessment shall be such as may be determined by the
8 Commissioners of the Water District and without regard to the zone and
9 termini method provided for in laws of 1947, Chapter 155, Section 1,
10 Page 717.

11 Section 3: That there is hereby established a Local Im-
12 provement District to be called Local Improvement District No. 12
13 which shall include the property described as follows:

14 Beginning at the Northeast corner of Section 29,
15 Township 28 North, Range 5 E.W.M.; thence South
16 to the Southeast corner of the $N\frac{1}{2} NE\frac{1}{4} NE\frac{1}{4}$ of
17 Section 29; thence West to the Southwest corner
18 of said $N\frac{1}{2} NE\frac{1}{4} NE\frac{1}{4}$; thence North to the Northwest
19 corner of $S\frac{1}{2} SE\frac{1}{4} SE\frac{1}{4}$ of Section 20, Township 28
20 North, Range 5 E.W.M.; thence East to the Northeast
21 corner of said $S\frac{1}{2} SE\frac{1}{4} SE\frac{1}{4}$; thence South to point of
22 beginning,

23 situate in Snohomish County, State of Washington.


24 Section 4: A special fund is hereby created to be called
25 Local Improvement District Fund No. 12 Construction Fund, which shall
26 consist in the aggregate of the several amounts assessed, levied and
27 collected on the lots, tracts, parcels of land and other property in
28 said Local Improvement District, and the proceeds of the sale of the
29 bonds of said District, for the purpose of defraying the costs and
30 expenses of such improvement as outlined in Section 2 herein. Out of
said fund shall be paid the warrants, interest thereon, and the cost
of the improvement herein provided for.


Section 5: That the costs and expenses of such improvement
shall be defrayed by special assessments, payable in ten equal annual
installments with interest thereon at a rate not to exceed six per
cent (6%) per annum, under the mode of "Payment by Bonds" as provided


1 by law. Bonds bearing interest at a rate not to exceed six per cent
2 (6%) per annum, payable on or before twelve years from date of issue
3 shall be issued in payment of said costs and expenses above mentioned.
