WHEREAS, RCW 57.08.050 requires that the District's Commissioners let contracts for Public Work, in excess of \$50,000, go through a competitive bidding process; and

WHEREAS, the District received bids for the Asphalt Paving Unit Price Contract on March 16, 2021, and the apparent low bid was submitted by JB Asphalt Paving, Inc., in the amount of \$254,813.44; and

WHEREAS, District staff have completed the review of JB Asphalt Paving, Inc. qualifications, and JB Asphalt Paving, Inc. is currently a Washington State registered and licensed contractor and appears to have the relevant qualifications and experience to successfully perform the work that the project will require; and

WHEREAS, the District Engineer recommends that the District award the Asphalt Paving Unit Price Contract to JB Asphalt Paving, Inc. as the lowest responsive and responsible bidder.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED THAT:

- **I.** The Asphalt Paving Unit Price Contract is hereby awarded to JB Asphalt Paving, Inc. as the lowest responsive, responsible bidder in an amount not-to-exceed \$500,000, including sales tax; and

- **3.** The District's General Manager, is hereby authorized to issue a Notice to Proceed to JB Asphalt Paving, Inc. as appropriate.
