RESOLUTION NO. 822**

A RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS OF THE SILVER LAKE WATER AND SEWER DISTRICT, SNOHOMISH COUNTY, WASHINGTON, AWARDED THE LIFT STATION NO. 4 GENERATOR REPLACEMENT PROJECT TO COLVICO, INC.

WHEREAS, RCW 57.08.050 requires that the District's Commissioners let contracts for Public Work, in excess of \$50,000, go through a competitive bidding process; and

WHEREAS, the District received bids for the Lift Station No. 4 Generator Replacement Project on December 21, 2021, and the apparent low bid was submitted by Colvico, Inc., in the amount of \$432,641.04; and

WHEREAS, District staff have completed the review of Colvico, Inc. qualifications, and Colvico, Inc. is currently a Washington State registered and licensed contractor and appears to have the relevant qualifications and experience to successfully perform the work that the project will require; and

WHEREAS, the District Engineer recommends that the District award the Lift Station No. 4 Generator Replacement Project to Colvico, Inc. as the lowest responsive and responsible bidder.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED THAT:

- 1.** The Lift Station No. 4 Generator Replacement Project is hereby awarded to Colvico, Inc. as the lowest responsive, responsible bidder, in the amount of \$432,641.04, including sales tax; and
- 2.** The District's General Manager is hereby authorized to execute the Contract on behalf of the District as appropriate; and
- 3.** The District's General Manager is hereby authorized to issue a Notice to Proceed to Colvico, Inc. as appropriate.


