WHEREAS, the Commissioners of Silver Lake Water and Sewer District are required to comply with Occupational Safety and Health Act (OSHA) and Washington Industrial Safety and Health Act (WISHA) laws and regulations concerning workplace health and safety; and

WHEREAS, all District employees are required to comply with safety requirements pertaining to their job duties; and

WHEREAS, the Silver Lake Water and Sewer District is committed to providing a safe and healthy work environment for its employees; and

WHEREAS, the District recognizes the need for development of safe working practices for every employee and desires to promote on-the-job safety by encouraging the proper use of equipment, tools, and other devices; and

WHEREAS, the District has recently participated with Archbright in an audit of facilities and safety programs; and

WHEREAS, the Silver Lake Water and Sewer District updated its Safety Manual and Policies in 2011, by resolution 672, Codified as Chapter 3.45 of the District Code; and

WHEREAS, over the last year District staff have reviewed consolidated, updated, and reorganized the existing District Safety Policy Manual and presented the 2023 Safety Policy Manual to the Commissioners for their review which includes the following Safety Policies and Programs:

- 5. This resolution shall be effective on the date of adoption as set forth below.
