RESOLUTION NO. 90

A RESOLUTION providing for a distribution system of water mains and doing all other work necessary to make a complete improvement in connection therewith, within the boundaries more fully described in the body of this Resolution, creating an assessment district, creating a Local Improvement District Fund therefor, providing that the costs and expenses of such improvement shall be paid by special assessments in ten equal annual installments under the mode of "Payment by Bonds", said bonds to bear interest at a rate not to exceed six per cent (6%) per annum.

WHEREAS, a Resolution of Intention was passed by the commissioners of Silver Lake Water District on the 8th day of December, 1958, providing that a system of water mains be constructed, and that all necessary work in connection therewith be done to conduct water from the Silver Lake Water Supply System to the property within the boundaries described in Section 3 hereof, all in accordance with plans and specifications submitted by the Engineer employed by the Board of Water District Commissioners, the estimated cost of such improvement being the sum of \$ 45900; that pipes used shall be of cement-asbestos or cast iron, together with all appurtenances and work incidental thereto of the approximate size in, on, along and under the following described streets, roads, alleys and easements:

An 8-inch pipe from Watts Road on Ninth Avenue to 128th Street; thence on Eleventh Avenue to 129th Street; thence on 129th Street to Dumas Road.

A 4-inch pipe from Watts Road on Tenth Avenue to 128th Street.

A 6-inch pipe from Tenth Avenue on 128th Street to 14th Avenue.

A 4-inch pipe from 14th Avenue to 128th Street east for 380 feet, plus or minus.

A 6-inch pipe from 129th Street on Eleventh Avenue to 132nd Street.

A 6-inch pipe from Eleventh Avenue on 130th Street to 14th Avenue.

A 4-inch pipe from Eleventh Avenue on 131st Street to 13th Avenue.

A 6-inch pipe from 13th Avenue on 131st Street east for 750 feet, plus or minus.

A 6-inch pipe from Eleventh Avenue on 132nd Street east for 1300 feet, plus or minus.

A 6-inch pipe from 130th Street on 13th Avenue to 132nd Street.

The water lines are to be installed as described above, together with the necessary gate valves, pressure reducing valves and appurtenances for the best operation of the water system as determined by the District Engineer employed by the Water District.

The District shall construct and install 4-inch standard fire hydrants in connection with the acquisition and construction of the water district lines throughout the District to be located in accordance with the requirements of the Washington Surveying and Rating Bureau for Zone 1 insurance rating wherever feasible.

WHEREAS, by Resolution No. 89 a hearing was ordered on said petition, to take place on the 12th day of January, 1959, at 8:00 P.M. at the Leo Nelson residence on the west side of Silver Lake, and it appearing that notice of said hearing has been given to the property owners in said proposed improvement district in accordance with said resolution and Revised Code of Washington, paragraph No. 57.16.060;

WHEREAS, after due hearing on said petition, it appears to the Commissioners of said Silver Lake Water District that more than sixty per cent (60%) of the owners of land within said district to be created as hereinafter described in Section 3 are all in favor of such improvement and that public convenience and necessity require that said improvements be made; NOW THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Commissioners of Silver Lake Water District, Snohomish County, Washington:

Section 1: That all of the territory within the boundaries described in Section 3 of this Resolution be improved by the construction and installation of a distribution system of water mains,

and that all work in connection therewith be done necessary to conduct water from the Silver Lake Water District water supply system to all of the property described in Section 3 of this Resolution, and that said water distribution system be constructed according to plans and specifications prepared under the direction of the Engineer employed by said Water District Commissioners for such purpose, which plans and specifications are hereby adopted and approved, the estimated cost of such improvement being the sum of \$ 45900, to be paid by the Local Improvement District. That detailed plans of said proposed improvement are hereby adopted, are attached hereto, marked Exhibit "A", and hereby made a part hereof.

Section 2: That all of the costs and expenses of such improvement shall be borne by and assessed against the property included in the assessment district herein created. Special assessments shall be levied against the property situated within such Local Improvement District in proportion to the special benefits to be derived by the property in such Local Improvement District from such improvement, the mode of assessment shall be such as may be determined by the Commissioners of the Water District and without regard to the zone and termini method provided for in laws of 1947, Chapter 155, Section 1, Page 717.

Section 3: That there is hereby established a Local Improvement District to be called Local Improvement District No. 13, which shall include the property described as follows:

Beginning at a point on the North-South center line of Section 30, Township 28 North, Range 5 East, W.M., which is 180 feet South of the Northeast corner of the $SE\frac{1}{4}$ $NE\frac{1}{4}$ $SW\frac{1}{4}$ of said section; thence West on a line parallel to and 180 feet South of the North line of said $SE\frac{1}{4}$ $NE\frac{1}{4}$ $SW\frac{1}{4}$ to intersection with the West line of said subdivision; thence South along West line of $SE\frac{1}{4}$ $NE\frac{1}{4}$ $SW\frac{1}{4}$ to the Southwest corner thereof; thence West along North line of $SE\frac{1}{4}$ $SW\frac{1}{4}$ Section 30 to intersection with center line of the Dumas Road; thence Southeasterly and Southerly along center line of Dumas Road to intersection with South line of Section 30; thence East along South line Section 30 to $S\frac{1}{4}$ corner of Section 30; thence South along North-South center line of Section 31 to South line $N\frac{1}{2}$ $N\frac{1}{2}$ $NW\frac{1}{4}$ $NE\frac{1}{4}$ of Section 31;

thence East along said South line to the East line of NW $\frac{1}{4}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$ Section 31; thence North along East line of NW $\frac{1}{4}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$ Section 31 and continuing North along East line SW $\frac{1}{4}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$ Section 30 to Northeast corner thereof; thence West along North line SW $\frac{1}{4}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$ Section 30 to Northwest corner thereof; thence North along North-South center line of Section 30 to point of beginning.

Section 4: A special fund is hereby created to be called Local Improvement District Fund No. 13 Construction Fund, which shall consist in the aggregate of the several amounts assessed, levied and collected on the lots, tracts, parcels of land and other property in said Local Improvement District, and the proceeds of the sale of the bonds of said District, for the purpose of defraying the costs and expenses of such improvement as outlined in Section 2 herein. Out of said fund shall be paid the warrants, interest thereon, and the cost of the improvements herein provided for.

Section 5: That the costs and expenses of such improvement shall be defrayed by special assessments, payable in ten equal annual installments with interest thereon at a rate not to exceed six per cent (6%) per annum, under the mode of "Payment by Bonds" as provided by law. Bonds bearing interest at a rate not to exceed six per cent (6%) per annum, payable on or before twelve years from date of issue shall be issued in payment of said costs and expenses above mentioned.
