RESOLUTION OF INTENTION NO. 13

A RESOLUTION OF INTENTION to provide for a distribution system of water mains and the doing of all other work necessary to make a complete improvement in connection therewith, within the boundaries more fully described in the body of this Resolution, creating an assessment district, creating a Local Improvement District Fund therefor, providing that the costs and expenses of such improvement shall be paid by special assessments in ten equal annual installments under the mode of "Payment by Bonds", said bonds to bear interest at a rate not to exceed six per cent (6%) per annum.

WHEREAS, a petition has been filed with the Silver Lake Water District, asking that the following portion of the general plan adopted by the Silver Lake Water District be ordered as follows:

1. That a distribution system of water mains, together with the necessary appurtenances thereto, be constructed in the territory hereinafter described and that all necessary work be done and all necessary material furnished, all in accordance with plans and specifications to be prepared by the Board of Water District Commissioners.
2. That a local improvement district be created to bear the cost and expense of such improvement.
3. That all work be done according to plans above referred to; that payment for said improvement shall be made by special assessments, payable in ten equal annual installments under the mode of "Payment by Bonds", said bonds to bear interest at a rate not to exceed six per cent (6%) per annum.
4. The property to be included in said local improvement is described in Section III hereof.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS OF SILVER LAKE WATER DISTRICT, SNOHOMISH COUNTY, WASHINGTON:

Section I. That all of the territory within the boundaries described in Section III of this Resolution be improved by the construction of a distribution system of water mains, and that all work in connection therewith be done, necessary to conduct water from the Silver Lake Water District water supply system to all of the property described in Section III of this Resolution, and that said water distribution system be constructed according to plans and specifications to be prepared under the direction of the Engineer employed by said Water District Commissioners, for such purpose, the estimated cost of such improvement being the sum of \$ 14,140.00; that pipes used shall be cement-asbestos or cast iron, together with all appurtenances and work incidental thereto of the approximate size in, on, along and under the following described streets, roads, alleys and easements:

6 inch pipe in Bothell Highway 1360 feet north from Jordan Road and
6 inch pipe East from Bothell Highway 1270 feet approximately along center of Preston C. Tieman Tract.
Construction to be a permanent type pipe with standard fire hydrants at proper spacing.

The water lines are to be installed as described above, together with the necessary gate valves, pressure reducing valves and appurtenances for the best operation of the water system as determined by the District Engineer employed by the Water District.

The District shall construct and install 4 inch standard fire hydrants in connection with the acquisition and construction of the water district lines throughout the District to be located in accordance with the requirements of the Washington Surveying and Rating Bureau for Zone 1 insurance rating wherever feasible.

Section II. That all of the costs and expenses of such improvement shall be borne by and assessed against the property included in the assessment district herein created. Special assessments shall be levied against the property situated within such local Improvement District in proportion to the special benefits to be derived by the property in such Local Improvement District from such improvement, the mode of assessment shall be such as may be determined by the Commissioners of the Water District and without regard to the zone and termini method provided for in Laws of 1947, Chapter 155, Section 1, Page 717.

Section III. That there is hereby established a local Improvement District to be called Local Improvement District No.

14, which shall include the property described as follows:

Beginning at the S.E. Corner of Section 18, Township 28 North, Range 5 E.; thence West 330 feet; thence North to the NW corner of the $E\frac{1}{2}$ $E\frac{1}{2}$ $SE\frac{1}{4}$ $SE\frac{1}{4}$ said Section 18; thence East along the North line of $SE\frac{1}{4}$ $SE\frac{1}{4}$ Section 18 and the North line of $SW\frac{1}{4}$ $SW\frac{1}{4}$ Section 17 to NE corner thereof; thence South to the SE corner of the $N\frac{1}{2}$ $N\frac{1}{2}$ $SW\frac{1}{4}$ $SW\frac{1}{4}$ Section 17; thence West to a point 330 feet East of the West line of Section 17; thence South parallel to said West line to intersection with the South line of Section 17; thence West to the point of beginning.

Section IV. That the costs and expenses of such improvement shall be defrayed by special assessments, payable in ten equal annual installments with interest thereon at the rate of six per cent per annum (6%), under mode of "Payment by Bonds", as provided by law.

Bonds bearing interest at the rate of six per cent (6%) per annum, payable on or before twelve years from date of issue shall be issued in payment of said costs and expenses above mentioned.

Section V. That a public hearing will be held on said Resolution of Intention on the 30th day of March, 1959, at 8:00 P.M. at the Leo Nelson home on the West side of Silver Lake, and it is directed that notice of said hearing be given each owner or reputed owner of any lot, tract, parcel of land or other property within the proposed improvement district by mailing said notice at least fifteen (15) days before the 30th day of March, 1959, to the owner or reputed owner of the property as shown on the tax rolls of the County Treasurer at the address shown thereon and that a copy of this resolution be published in at least two consecutive issues of the Everett Daily Herald in Everett, Snohomish County, Washington, the date of first publication to be at least fifteen (15) days prior to the said 30th day of March, 1959.

Section VI. All persons desiring to object to the formation of said district must file their written protests with the Secretary of the Board of Water Commissioners before the time fixed for said public hearing.
