

SILVER LAKE WATER DISTRICT MEETING  
July 11, 1955

Meetings of regular meeting of Silver Lake Water District held on July 11, 1955 at 8:00 P. M. at the home of Leo Nelson, Silver Lake, Washington. The meeting was called to order by President Jake Michel, Jr.

All the commissioners being present and in addition, C. W. Jordan, attorney; Richard Wolff, engineer; Mr. Frank Misho, representing Pope & Talbot; and a number of other people were present, as follows: *Mr. &*

Due to the absence of the minutes, the minutes were dispensed with until the next meeting,

The first order of business was a hearing on Resolution No. 51. After considerable discussion it was decided to form L.I.D. No. 6; in accordance with the recommendation of the engineer, the district to pay additional cost of a 6" pipe over a 4" pipe on Robeck Street, the balance of the cost to be paid out of the local improvement district, and upon motion Resolution No. 53 was adopted forming said district.

Mr. Misho indicated that while he had no objection to the formation of the district and to the cost he did object, on behalf of Pope & Talbot, to the method of assessment; feeling that under the method of assessment proposed by the engineer some of the lots would be assessed too high, and he protested the method of assessment. Upon a vote of those present, on the question, 13 were in favor of said resolution No. 51 and 2 against it.

One man wanted to know if it wouldn't be cheaper to lay a 4" line on each side of the road and the engineer said that it would not be and it would cost no more to connect on one side of the road than the other even if the line had to be laid across the road for each house as the meter charge of \$75.00 covered that.

There was a hearing also held on Resolution No. 52 but due to the fact that the proposed improvement was not in the Silver Lake Water District, nothing could be done on the resolution.

Mr. Cottle from Ruggs Lake asked that the assessment on the community lot be laid upon all the other property proportionately. Mr. Jordan was to see what could be done about that.

Mr. Wolff advised the commissioners that the new map he was making would be ready at the next meeting.

Mr. Nelson made a motion which was seconded and carried that the engineer prepare a call for bids on L.I.D. No. 6 for the next meeting, August 8, 1955.
