

Minutes of the Silver Lake Water District
Meeting held on the 13th day of February, 1956.

Meeting held at the Leo Nelson home and was called to order by Jake Michel at 8:00 P.M.

Those present included all commissioners, C. W. Jordan, the attorney for the district, Richard E. Wolff, engineer; John Klint; Mr. Vechers of the Silver Lake Fire District and Mr. B. T. Moore of the Washington Tax Commission.

Mr. Moore stated that the Silver Lake Water District had not paid their sales tax for the year 1948. A motion made by Mr. Michel and seconded by Mr. Nelson that the tax be paid, was carried.

Mr. Wolff gave progress estimates on L.I.D. #6 and L.I.D. #7. A motion was properly made, seconded and carried that they be accepted and paid. *The progress estimate on L.I.D. #6 street job completed and upon motion same was accepted.*

Mr. Jordan reported on the tax title property and stated that he had secured a title report on same. There seemed to be some question in the minds of the commissioners as to whether it should be sold at this time, so the matter was held over.

61A Mr. Wolff, the engineer, reported that the petition for annexation of property on the Green Lantern Road now comprised more than 60% of the land owners and Resolution No. 61A was passed providing for hearing on the 12th day of March, 1956.
