

Minutes of Silver Lake Water District
meeting held on the 10th day of September, 1956.

Meeting was held at the Leo Nelson home and was called to order by Jake Michel at 8:00 P.M.

Those present included Mrs. Pauline Bothne, Donald Bothne, Nels Peters, W. V. Kononen, C. E. Oster, Wally R. Hanning, John Rand, Chas. Ready, Wendall H. Barnes, and all commissioners, and C. W. Jordan, attorney for the district, and Richard E. Wolff, engineer.

Minutes of the previous meeting were read and approved.

The hearing on L.I.D. No. 9 met with some disapproval, there being two letters of protest and one verbal protest. After some discussion, there was a decision by the commissioners to take same under advisement for one month.

There was also some discussion as to L.I.D. No. 8, and upon motion properly made and carried, declaration of Resolution of Intention No. 70 was adopted and October 8, 1956 was set for hearing thereon.

Mr. Wendall Barnes presented an additional insurance bill to the district. A motion was properly made and carried that same be accepted.

Resolution No. 71 was adopted providing for a public hearing on the 8th day of October, 1956 at 8:00 P.M. on whether or not the following described property, to-wit:

East Half (E $\frac{1}{2}$) of Southwest Quarter (SW $\frac{1}{4}$) Section Thirty (30), Township Twenty-eight (28), North, Range Five (5), East, W.M., situated in Snohomish County, Washington,

should be annexed to the Silver Lake Water District.
