

Minutes of Silver Lake Water District held on October 8, 1956.

Meeting was called to order by the chairman at 8:00 P.M. Minutes of the previous meeting were read and approved, as read.

Those present were commissioners Jack Michel and Leo Nelson; the engineer, Richard Wolff; attorney, C. W. Jordan; a delegation from Green Lantern Road, Edward I. Butler, R. H. Fossum, Chester R. Jackson, J. W. Whitman, Wm. Mark, Sam Morgan, Wally Hanning, Mr. and Mrs. C. Reeves and Nels Peters and Don Bothne from L.I.D. 9. Also Mr. G. J. Vickers and Mr. F. M. Misho of Pope & Talbot.

There were several protests to L.I.D. 8 and after some discussion a motion was properly made and carried that same be laid over for another month for further consideration.

With relation to L.I.D. 9, Resolution No. 73 forming L.I.D. 9 was passed. This involved a change in location of the large main and took care of the protests that were heard before because those people were eliminated from the proposed district. Resolution No. 74 was adopted annexing the following described property to the Silver Lake District:

East Half (E½) of Southwest Quarter (SW¼) Section Thirty (30), Township Twenty-eight (28), North Range Five (5), East, W.M., situated in Snohomish County, Washington,

A motion was made and carried that Mr. Wolff specify that union labor be employed on all jobs, when preparing specifications.

Engineer was instructed to call for bids on L.I.D. 9 to be opened at the next meeting on November 12, 1956, at 8:00 P.M.


Resolution No. 72 providing for a budget for the fiscal year 1957 was adopted.
