

Minutes of the Silver Lake Water District Meeting held on the 25th day of August, 1971 at 2210 132nd St. SE, Everett, Washington.

The meeting was called to order at 8:00 PM by President Charles Fisher. The minutes of the August 11 meeting were read, approved and signed by the Secretary.

Financial statement for July were distributed to the Commissioners.

Engineer's Report: Engineer Kegel reported on a treatment to preserve steel pipe.

The Silver Lake Water District maps are in Seattle being reproduced.

Superintendent's Report:

1. At a recent meeting of the Fircrest Sewer District, their Commissioners agreed they would help pay for a truck to be used to pull the generator. Mr. Saunders will attend a Water District meeting in the near future to discuss the matter further.

2. The line on Dexter Avenue has been lowered.

3. Air Conditioning for the office has been ordered from Comfort-Air, Inc. and installation has been started.

4. A representative of the paint manufacturer was out in connection with our complaint that the walls still leak. They were authorized to repaint the blocks 7 courses up from the ground and were told this would not be acceptable. The final decision is that they will repaint the entire building.

5. A Weyerhaeuser representative was out regarding the warped doors. In a later telephone conversation he indicated that a letter will be sent to the Water District.

6. Mr. Russell Osborn has made a request for the Water District personnel to drill a line under this driveway for his personal use. The commissioners agreed that no work should be done on any private property.

There being no further Business, the meeting adjourned until the next regular meeting to be held September 8, 1971.
