Minutes of the Silver Lake Water District meeting held on the 24th day of November 1971 at 2210 132nd St. S.E., Everett, Wa.

The meeting was called to order at 7:00 P.M. by President Charles Fisher. The minutes of the November 10 meeting were read, approved and signed by the Secretary.

A letter from Shirley Bartholomew, News Director of KRKO Radio Station was noted. This was a request to be notified of any special meetings.

An agreement with customers desiring service from Mukilteo Water District was discussed and signed by the President and Secretary.

A pay raise for Marie Skucy was discussed, it being noted that at the time of employment she was told there would be an increase of \$50.00 per month after 6 months (October 1). This was not possible under the Price Wage Freeze. Phase 2 of that program would allow a maximum increase at this time of \$25.00 per month. A motion was made by Jake Michel and seconded by Leo Nelson to increase the salary of Marie Skucy by \$25.00 a month to be effective December 1, 1971. Motion carried. It was also noted that the other \$25.00 raise will be given as soon as possible under the Federal Regulations.

Meter yokes and copper fittings have been stolen from installations in Division 1 of Puget Park. Quadrant Corporation will be advised.

A plan to place a Christmas decoration on the top of the tank has been checked out and approved by the Insurance Company and County.
