The meeting was called to order at 7:00 o'clock P. M. by President Charles Fisher. The mingtes of the January 12 meeting were read by Supt. Heisel, approved and signed by Secretary Michel.

A letter received from Accountant Sjoholm, XXX suggesting investments, was read by Supt. Heisel. After reviewing the letter, the Commissioners passed unanimously the following Resolutions:

Revenue Bond Fund Investment
Transfer Cash Reserve Account to the Bank of
Everett Savings Account.
Reduce the \$600.00 monthly transfer to \$125.00,
effective March 1, 1972.
Change the amount of the monthly transfer from
the Maintenance Fund to the Revenue Bond Fund
from \$2,037.00 to \$3,250.00, effective February 1.

The financial statements were distributed for period ending December 31, 1971.

Supt. Heisel brought up the matter of low pressure on the old line on 25th Ave. off Ruggs Loop Road. Engineer Kegel suggested that the people effected should attend a meeting to confer with the Board.

Engineer Kegel stated that John Friel is working on the survey forms and should have them ready within the next few days.

Supt. Report: 1. The 1971 office records have been delivered to accountant Sjoholm, and that he will attend the Feb. 9 meeting to discuss the Financial Report. 2. letters recommending the installation of pressure

reducing valves have been mailed to customers in Books 11 and 12.

3. Brought up the need for a copy machine.

4. Will attend the classes in Tacoma Jan. 3D (31) -Feb.3, conducted by the State Dept. of Health, on Cross Connection prevention.

Supt. Heisel was authorized to get prices on copy machines.

There being no further business, the meeting adjourned.
