The meeting was called to order at 7:00 P.M. by President Charles Fisher. The minutes of the March 8 meeting were read and approved.

There was a discussion of a letter from the U.S. District Court, Northern District of Alabama, relative to a lawsuit which has been filed by the State of Washington against certain manufacturers of cast iron pipe and fittings. On the advice of Attorney Jordan, a motion was made and passed that the District request exclusion. A letter to that effect was signed by Secretary Michel.

A letter from Washington State Department of Commerce and Economic Development contained a Digest of Economic Assistance Act of 1972. This would provide loans and grants for Public Facilities Construction.

A news letter from Snohomish County Planning Department was noted.

The monthly financial statements were distributed.

Mr. Friel presented the water distribution plan for the Plat of View Eidge East in the Seattle-Hill area. This plan is in accord with the District design requirements and will be constructed and paid for by the developer. A motion was made by Mr. Michel to accept the plan. The motion carried.

There was a discussion of the proposed ULID #20. Attorney Jordan stated that the legal discription must accompany the petition when signatures are secured. A correct petition will be prepared by his office for signatures of the property owners involved. It was noted that several residents are not recorded as the legal owners in the County Auditors office. It will be necessary for these residents to have their Real Estate contracts recorded if their signatures are to be acceptable on the petition.

There being no further business, the meeting adjourned at 7:40.
