MINUTES OF THE SPECIAL MEETING OF COMMISSIONERS OF THE SILVER LAKE WATER & SEWER DISTRICT

December 30, 2022

The special meeting of the Board of Commissioners of the Silver Lake Water & Sewer District was held on December 30, 2022, beginning at 1:30 p.m. Attending in person was Commissioner John Warner. Also present in person were General Manager Curt Brees and O&M Manager Ron Berger. Commissioners Anne Backstrom and Shauna Willner; Eric Delfel with Gray & Osborne, Inc., and Curtis Chambers with Inslee, Best, Doezie & Ryder P.S., Attorney for the District, attended via videoconference. The public was provided access to participate both in person at the meeting and via teleconference, with the telephone number and access code published on the District's website and posted at the District Administration Building (regular meeting location). Notice of the Special meeting time was posted on the District website, the District Administration Building, and provided to the Everett Herald.

1.) CALL TO ORDER:

Commissioner Warner called the meeting to order at 1:30 p.m.

2.) PUBLIC COMMENT:

No one from the public attended this meeting for comment.

3.) MAINTENANCE & OPERATIONS REPORTS:

a.) <u>Declaring the Existence of an Emergency – Repair of a District Force Main – Waive</u> Formal Bid Process Requirements

Mr. Brees and Mr. Berger provided a verbal report to the Board of Commissioners regarding a recent emergency situation and need of a sewer force main repair.

The District was notified of a potential sewage leak on 116th Street SE & 40th Drive SE by a member of the public on December 25, 2022. Responding crews determined the probable cause, based on location, is a leak in a 10-inch Cast Iron Force main, carrying untreated sewer flows from the Waldenwood Lift Station.

District crews attempted a repair of the leak on December 26, 2022, and after considerable effort, it was determined that the pipe bury depth at the location of the leak is more than the capability of the District's equipment to perform the excavation and safely shore the trench walls.

District staff provided notice to Washington Department of Ecology, Snohomish County Surface Water Management Division, and the Snohomish Health District, of the leak on December 27, 2022, and have been advised that repair and remediation of the leak/spill is required as soon as it is feasible to accomplish the work.

District staff recommended an emergency be declared and that competitive bed requirements set forth in Chapter 57.08.050 RCW for this work be waived.

Following discussion, by motion made, seconded, and carried unanimously, the Board of Commissioners approved and adopted Resolution No. 837, declaring an emergency, waiving competitive bidding requirements, and directing the General Manager to procure a contractor to complete the repairs to the broken sewer force main.
